Single-stream Recycling Guidelines

Please do **not** use plastic bags for your recyclables!

Place all recyclable items in the same container. No separation is necessary! Please have collection containers out to the curb the night before collection and take containers back by the evening of collection.

Containers may not exceed 49 lbs.!

Recycle these materials

**Paper • Plastics • Glass
 Aluminum & Steel • Cardboard**

Please also recycle:

- **Cartons: milk, broth, juice boxes, etc.**
- **Empty Paint Cans: remove lid**
- **Paper Egg Cartons**
- **Hardback Books: remove cover**
- **Empty Aerosol Cans**
- **Other boxes: food, cereal, shoe, pizza or gift boxes**
- **Any plastic container imprinted on the bottom with a:**



Maximum size: 3 gallons

The following items are NOT accepted

- **Styrofoam**
- **Mirrors or broken glass**
- **Plastic Bags (some retail stores accept these for recycling)**
- **Paper plates, towels or plastic utensils**
- **Aluminum Foil**
- **Pots & Pans, Dishware or Flatware**
- **Hazardous or medical waste**
- **Wire clothes hangers**
- **Light bulbs (CFLs or standard)**

Electronics ACUA does not accept electronics. State law prohibits electronics from being disposed of as trash. First, contact public works, at (609) 646-0664, to inquire if they have a collection program. If not, visit acua.com/electronics for other options.

Latex Paint Latex paint is not hazardous waste and dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. Go to acua.com/paint for more information.

Large/Rigid Plastics Other plastic items (toys, chairs, PVC pipe, VHS tapes, buckets) are recyclable at no charge through the ACUA's large/rigid plastic drop-off. Go to acua.com/rigidplastics for more information.

Bulky Waste Two items per trash day including furniture and carpeting. No construction waste, TVs or electronics.

Batteries Alkaline batteries can be disposed of in the trash, as they no longer contain mercury. Rechargeable batteries can be disposed of at the Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off at ACUA. Go to acua.com/hhw for more information.

Recycling & Trash Collection Zones

Monday: White Horse Pike / Absecon Blvd. South to California Ave. / Wescoat Rd., East to Nevada Ave.

Tuesday: White Horse Pike / Absecon Blvd. North to West Curran Ave. / New York Rd., East to Weilers Ave. / Burning Tree Blvd.

Wednesday: Pitney Rd. East to New York Rd., Church St. North to Connecticut Ave. / Webb Rd.

Thursday: Pitney Rd. West to Ambassador Ave. / Elm St., White Horse Pike / Absecon Blvd. North to Upland Ave.

Friday: Ambassador Ave. West to Ritz Ave., White Horse Pike / Absecon Blvd. North to Highland Blvd. / Arc Ct.

Yard Waste Collection Guidelines & Sectors

Yard Waste (leaves, brush, grass, clean wood) Must be placed in kraft bags or properly marked containers. Plastic bags are not permitted. Brush/branches must be tied with twine & should not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter. Bags or containers should not exceed 49 lbs.

Sector A: East side of Shore Road to the bay; North Curran to White Horse Pike, South White Horse Pike to California Ave.

Sector B: West side of Shore Road to Galloway Twp. border, Upland Ave. to White Horse Pike.
