ORDINANCE 08-2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABSECON AMENDING CHAPTER 216 OF THE CITY OF ABSECON CODE, GOVERNING HOTEL AND MOTEL REGISTRATION

WHEREAS, City of Absecon, operating under the City form of government, is governed by statutes, that allow the City Council to pass, adopt, amend and repeal any ordinance or, where permitted, any resolution for any purpose required for the government of the municipality or for the accomplishment of any public purpose for which the municipality is authorized to act under general law; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 216-1 of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Absecon currently outlines the requirements for Hotel and Motel Registration within the confines the City of Absecon; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 216-1 of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Absecon currently is silent as to how long a length of stay for "transient occupancy" is allowed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it desirable, and in the best interest of the City and its citizens to limit the length of stay for "transient occupancy" within its borders and to increase the fine for violations of this Code section; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Absecon, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 216-1 of the City of Absecon Municipal Code is hereby amended, replaced and superseded as follows:

Chapter 216. HOTEL AND MOTEL REGISTRATION

216-1. Registry required; information and identification, occupancy limits.

A. Every hotel and motel in the City of Absecon shall be required to maintain at all times a registry identifying the name of each registrant of each rooming unit, together with the principle residence address of such registrant of each rooming unit, together with the principal residence address of such registrant and the date upon which his/her occupancy of such rooming unit commenced. The registrant shall sign the registry and must produce a valid driver's license or other identification. A copy of a valid driver's license or other identification must be kept on file and is subject to review by the Code Enforcement Officer of the City of Absecon upon periodic inspection.

B. Vehicle identification. Each registrant who is parking a motor vehicle in the hotel or motel lot shall provide the make, model and license plate number of that vehicle.

C. "Transient occupancy" means occupancy in hotels and motels for a period of occupancy which does not exceed 14 days. Except as otherwise set forth in this article, no hotel or motel guest may occupy a hotel or motel unit in such facility for more than 14 consecutive days or 14 days within any thirty-day period and may not extend such occupancy by moving into another unit within the same facility.

D. Any owner of any hotel or motel found to be in violation of this article will be subject to the issuance of violations, fines and court appearances when necessary, as set forth below. Any owner of any hotel or motel found to be in violation of this article will be subject to the following fine: For the first violation, a fine of not less than \$250 and not exceeding \$2,500 shall be imposed. A second violation within one year of the date of a previous violation shall result in an additional fine as a repeat offender. The additional fine imposed by the court for a repeat violation shall be not less than the minimum of \$500 or exceed the maximum fine of \$2,500 but shall be calculated separately from the fine chapter may, in the discretion of the court, and in default of the payment of any fine imposed therefore, be imprisoned in the Atlantic County Jail for a term not exceeding 90 days or be required to perform community service for a period not exceeding 90 days.

Section 2. All other ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect within twenty (20) days of final passage and publication, as provided by law.

ORDINANCE 09-2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABSECON AMENDING CHAPTER 258 OF THE CITY OF ABSECON CODE, GOVERNING LEGALIZED RAFFLE AND BINGO LICENSES

WHEREAS, City of Absecon, operating under the City form of government, is governed by statutes, that allow the City Council to pass, adopt, amend and repeal any ordinance or, where permitted, any resolution for any purpose required for the government of the municipality or for the accomplishment of any public purpose for which the municipality is authorized to act under general law;

WHEREAS, the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Absecon currently is silent as the fees charged by the City for legalized raffle and bingo licenses;

WHEREAS, an Ordinance setting the fees charges by the City for legalized raffle and bingo licenses the same are set by default under the New Jersey Statutes and Regulations;

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it desirable, and in the best interest of the City and its citizens to limit the fees charged by the City for raffle and bingo licenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Absecon, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. A new Article III to Chapter 258 of the City of Absecon Municipal Code shall be added as follows:

Article III Legalized Raffle and Bingo Licenses.

258-16. License Fee for Raffles.

- A.** There are raffle license fees payable to New Jersey Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission set by Statute and or regulation and collectible by the City that change from time to time.
- B.** In addition to any license fee required by New Jersey State Statute or Regulation to be paid to New Jersey Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission, a municipal raffle license fee of an equal amount shall be charged and payable to the City. However, the municipal raffle license fee paid to the City shall be limited to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per raffle.

258-16. License Fee for Bingo.

- A.** There are bingo license fees payable to New Jersey Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission set by Statute and or regulation and collectible by the City that change from time to time.

- B.** In addition to any license fee required by New Jersey State Statute or Regulation to be paid to New Jersey Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission, a municipal bingo license fee of an equal amount shall be charged and payable to the City. However, the municipal bingo license fee paid to the City shall be limited to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per bingo event.

Section 2. All other ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect within twenty (20) days of final passage and publication, as provided by law.

RESOLUTION 61-2023

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABSECON
AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN CITY OWNED LAND**

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that certain municipally owned land designated as Block 232 Lot 24 on the tax map of the City of Absecon (hereinafter referred to as the "subject property" or the "property"), is no longer necessary for municipal purposes and as such shall be sold at public auction in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13; and

WHEREAS, the Local Lands and Building Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1, et seq., authorizes the sale by municipalities of any real property, capital improvement, or personal property no longer needed for public use;

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is in the best interest of the City of Absecon to sell the subject property to generate revenue, reduce taxes, and reduce liability; and

WHEREAS, the subject property which is not needed for public purpose shall be sold at a public sale to be held on the same date as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Absecon to advertise this property for public sale to the highest bidder in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Absecon, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The allegations of the preamble are incorporated herein by this reference.
2. The City Clerk is authorized, subject to the conditions set forth herein, to offer for sale by public auction to the highest bidder all of the City's right, title and interest in the subject property listed on the municipal tax map of the City of Absecon pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.
3. The minimum bid for the subject property is One Thousand Dollars 0/100 (\$1,000.00). No bid less than the minimum amount set forth will be considered.
4. The City Clerk is directed to advertise the sale in a newspaper circulating in the City by two (2) insertions at least once a week during two (2) consecutive weeks, the last publication to be not earlier than seven (7) days prior to the date of the public sale.
5. The subject property is not necessary for public municipal purposes and the best interest of the public shall be served in selling the property by public sale to the highest bidder at or above the minimum price of One Thousand Dollars 0/100 (\$250,000.00) with the City Council reserving the right to accept or reject or otherwise remove the property from sale.
6. Said public auction shall be conducted on Thursday, April 27th at 10:00 a.m. EST or such later date or time as may be established and advertised by the City Clerk. Said public auction sale shall be conducted at the City of Absecon Municipal building, 500 Mill Road, Absecon, New Jersey 08201 or such other place as designated by the City Clerk and

published in accordance with law, subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein. Each bidder wishing to submit a bid and participate in the auction shall be registered as a bidder prior to the sale by contacting the City Clerk, City of Absecon, 500 Mill Road, Absecon, New Jersey, telephone number (609) 641-0663. The subject property is less than the minimum size required for development under the municipal zoning ordinance and is without any capital improvement thereon. It shall be first offered by auction to the owners of contiguous land in accordance with N.J.A.C. 40A:12-13 (b)(5) and sold to the highest bidding contiguous owner of land, if any. If no owners of contiguous land bid at the auction, the property auction shall then be opened up to all other bidders. The sale shall be to the highest bidder at the auction subject to approval of City Council. No bid shall be considered unless it is made orally at the auction. The City Clerk may establish such other appropriate procedures for the auction as deemed necessary.

7. The City Clerk shall notify all owners of land contiguous to the subject property of the auction by certified mail and include a copy of this Resolution. Said notice to be mailed no later than Fourteen (14) days prior to the public sale.
8. On the scheduled date and time of the public sale, the Mayor or City Clerk may by announcement to the public, adjourn the date and time to a later announced date and time not later than thirty (30) days after the original date. Said announcement shall be deemed adequate notice to all interested parties.
9. The highest bid shall be referred to the City Council for review and final approval pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13 and the City reserves the right to accept the highest bid or to reject any and all bids for the property. The Deposits with respect to any unsuccessful bid and any rejected bid shall be then returned.
10. A deposit of 10 percent of the minimum price for the property must be paid in cash, certified check, bank check or money order payable to the City of Absecon by the successful bidder at the time of the public sale; said time and place to be set by the City Clerk. This deposit shall be made subject to return in the event of rejection of said bid. The balance, together with the costs of sale and legal expenses must be deposited in full by either cash or certified bank check within twenty (20) days after the date of sale or acceptance of bid whichever is later at the office of the City Clerk.
11. The successful bidder shall be responsible for the cost of preparation of the deed of conveyance and any related documents for the transfer of title by the City Attorney, or for the City Attorney's review and approval of the documents not to exceed \$300.00, as well as the cost of recording the Deed with the Atlantic County Clerk. The balance of the purchase price, together with cost of preparation of the deed of conveyance and related documents for the transfer of title and the Atlantic County recording fee must be paid by certified check, money order or bank check made payable to the City of Absecon and provided to the City Clerk within twenty (20) days of the date of sale.
12. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute said Bargain and Sale deed without covenants and other conveyance documents and the City Attorney is authorized to prepare such deed and other documents on behalf of the City after the City Council accepts the bid offer.
13. In addition to the terms and conditions set forth herein, the successful bidder agrees to the imposition of the following conditions of the City:

- a. Acceptance of the offer to purchase shall constitute a binding agreement by the bidder and the successful bidder shall be deemed obligated to comply with the terms and conditions contained herein.
- b. In the event that the successful bidder fails to close title, the bidder agrees to forfeit to the City any and all monies deposited with the City.
- c. The City does not warrant or certify title to the property and in no event shall the City be liable for any damages to the successful bidder if title is found defective or unmarketable for any reason, and the bidder waives any and all rights and damages against the City, the sole remedy being the right to receive a refund of deposit paid prior to closing in the event title is found defective or unmarketable. It is the right of the successful bidder to examine title prior to closing. In the event of closing and a later finding of a defect of title, the Township shall not be required to refund any money or correct any defect in title and shall not be held liable for damages. Acceptance of an offer to purchase shall constitute a binding agreement by the bidder and the successful bidder shall be deemed obligated to comply with the terms and condition contained herein.
- d. The land being conveyed is an undersized lot and may not be developed separately for residential or other purposes and, if applicable, must be merged with the contiguous land owned by the bidder. The deed of conveyance shall contain a restriction governing the subject property indicating that, if applicable, neither it nor the property with which it is consolidated shall be further subdivided. The deed will also contain a further covenant that neither purchaser, nor any future owner or developer of the consolidated lots may ever, in any manner, directly or indirectly, assert a claim against the City of Absecon based upon the inability to develop or use the subject property, including, but not limited to, a claim of inverse condemnation or damages of any kind.
- e. The deed of conveyance shall be subject to all matters of record which may affect title, what an accurate survey would reveal, the Ordinances of the City of Absecon, and the reservation of an easement for all natural or constructed drainage systems, swales, pipes, drains, inlets, waterways and easements, if any, on the land without obligation to provide access, public or private, or to provide any improvements.
- f. The deed will also contain a further covenant that neither the purchaser nor any future owner or potential developer of the property may ever in any manner, directly or indirectly, assert a claim against the City of Absecon based upon the inability to develop or use the property including, but not limited to, a claim for inverse condemnation or damages of any kind.
- g. The City makes no warranties whatsoever regarding the property and assumes no responsibility for environmental conditions, known or unknown, regarding said property and the successful bidder agrees to fully release and indemnify the City with respect thereto. The bidder shall be fully responsible for the exercise of due diligence in determining all aspects of the condition of the property, including but not limited to, the determination of any title conditions, environmental conditions, zoning and development restrictions and any other condition or restriction that might impact the

use of land. The City sells the property "AS IS" in which the bidder releases the City of all liability and responsibility of any said contamination, if found, on the site.

14. The City Clerk, the Mayor and the City Attorney are authorized to prepare and execute any and all such documents and to take any and all such actions as may be required to affect the transactions set forth herein.
15. The City Clerk shall file with the Director of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs, sworn affidavits verifying the publications of the advertisements required by N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b), if necessary.
16. Bidding may be made by an individual, corporation or other entity. Bids may also be submitted by a prospective purchaser's attorney, real estate agent or broker or other duly authorized representative. However, no commission shall be paid by the City of Absecon to any real estate agent or broker or other representative in connection with any sale.
17. The sale of the property is subject to applicable New Jersey Law concerning this disposition of municipal real estate and all other applicable laws, regulations and ordinances of the State of New Jersey and the City of Absecon.
18. All potential sales are subject to final approval by the City Council. This includes the right of the City Council to remove the property from sale at any time and to terminate any sale up to the time of the issuance of a deed to the purchaser. If terminated by the City, any monies paid by a successful bidder will be refunded.
19. The City reserves the right to waive any and all defects, informalities and irregularities in any bid. The City further reserves the right to reject all bids in each instance where the highest bid is not accepted and it is, in its discretion, to re-advertise the property for sale. No bid shall be considered finally accepted until confirmed by the City Council.
20. If any word, phrase, clause, section or provision in this Resolution shall be found by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal, or unconstitutional, such word phrase, clause, section or provision shall be severable from the balance of the Resolution and the remainder of the Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
21. This Resolution shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
