**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABSECON AMENDING ORDINANCE
#11-2024 – AMENDING CHAPTER 254 OF THE CITY OF ABSECON
CODE THEREOF TITLED PEACE AND GOOD ORDER**

WHEREAS, City of Absecon, operating under the City form of government, is governed by statutes, that allow the City Council to pass, adopt, amend and repeal any ordinance or, where permitted, any resolution for any purpose required for the government of the municipality or for the accomplishment of any public purpose for which the municipality is authorized to act under general law; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 254-6 of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Absecon currently outlines the regulation regarding Begging within the confines the City of Absecon; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has amended the Code of the City of Absecon to include this regulation under Chapter 258; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABSECON CITY, NEW JERSEY that Chapter 254, be amended as follows:

Section 254-6 – Begging – Be deleted in its entirety

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

1. Any Ordinance or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.
2. This ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication as required by Law.
